

## Using Learning Bird with Your Class

Here are a few ideas to help you get started using Learning Bird with your class.

### Using Learning Bird in your class for the first time

- Give your students a better understanding of what Learning Bird is by showing them the Student Introduction Video you received at the beginning of the year.
- Explain to students how you will be using Learning Bird (ie. to view resources in class, to complete activities as a group, to show resources connected to class content etc.)
- View resources together as a class to familiarize yourselves with the Learning Bird platform and resources. We suggest showing students one handout or slideshow, and one video so that students will be able to get an idea of how Learning Bird resources are put together.
- For more ideas on how to use Learning Bird in your class, take a look at the other support documents that were left at your school after the training.

### Having students access your class page for the first time

- Have the Learning Bird class link poster in a place where your students can see it while accessing Learning Bird. Direct students to find your name in the list of teachers and then to click on their class.
- Make sure you have already published a resource or a resource kit to your class page for your students to view.
- Explain to students how you have set up the sections on your class page and what each section will be for.
- If resources are part of a kit, show students how to find the next resource in the kit.
- Show students how to get back to the class page.
